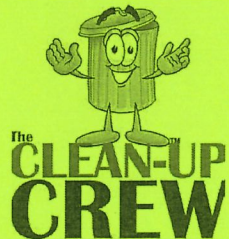

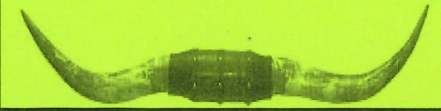
To the Drop-Off site

treated, painted, stained or particle board.
