# Subject to be Discussed

Hiring of a Part-Time Public Works Worker

The counteroffer from candidate number 4 was read. It was noted the candidate is asking for \$18.00/hr. rather than the \$16.50 documented in the offer letter. Discussion ensued. It was noted the Council would like to counteroffer with a wage increase to \$17.00/hr. with the opportunity to increase, up to the budgeted amount of \$20.00/hr. based on performance, in 60 days.

Councilor Jordan Hackwith moved to approve sending a counteroffer to candidate number 4 a wage increase to \$17.00/hr. with the opportunity to increase, up to the budgeted amount of \$20.00/hr. based on performance, in 60 days. Councilor Alan Cadinha seconded. Motion approved by unanimous vote.

Billing Clerk Wage Increase. Approved in Budget 2022-2023.

The wage increase for the Billing Clerk was noted to be approved in the budget for up to \$20.00/hr. It was noted the Billing Clerk is meeting expectations and a wage increase would be appropriate.

Motion: Councilor Jason Stone moved to approve the Billing Clerk wage increase to \$20.00/hr., as approved in the 2022-23 budget, retroactive to July 1, 2022. Councilor Jordan Hackwith seconded. Motion approved by unanimous vote.

Discuss Using a City Attorney

It was noted we do already have a city attorney retained, so there is no need to discuss retaining someone else. However, it was discussed a meeting is scheduled on July 26, 2022, with the Superintendent of Cove School, Sherry Riley, and Dave Johnson to discuss the school's construction of a parking lot on land that is currently commercially zoned, but also semi-public zoned. The Superintendent is requesting an opinion on land use and zoning from the city attorney. It was noted at this point there is not enough time for an attorney to review the information and present an opinion. Discussion ensued and it was noted the Superintendent does not feel they need to go through the application process because they aren't building a structure, they are just relocating the parking lot down the street. It was concluded at the July 26th meeting to ask the Superintendent to fill out an application and ask for a zoning change for the part of the land that is zoned commercial. Because school will be starting soon, and they want the parking lot in place prior to that, it was noted there may need to be a special meeting called to review the information from the school and act on it. However, it was also noted a lack of preparation on the school's part does not constitute an emergency on the City's part.
